This award is for researches and analysts of various aspects of the energy sector in the region or in Sri Lanka

SLEMA is sponsoring this award for the best energy-related study, conducted either at your workplace or through your own initiative. Typical projects that qualify for this award are,

- Study on the National Energy Policy and related issues.
- Preparation of plans for cost-effective supply and delivery of energy at utility-level or at institutional level.
- Research studies to optimize performance of renewable energy systems.
- Research studies to optimize environmental impacts of large energy conversion/delivery systems or institutional-level systems.
- Authoritative reviews of Regional, National or Institutional energy policy and plans.

For this award, research papers already prepared for or published in professional journals are also acceptable as submissions.

ENERGY MANAGEMENT AWARDS

To recognize outstanding achievements in the Energy Sector, SLEMA presents three annual awards.

- 1 Prof Mohan Munasinghe Award for the best energy management project awarded to an individual or a group.
- 2 Ceylon Petroleum Corporation Award for an institution for the best project on energy management.
- 3 SLEMA award for the best energy related study awarded to an individual or a group.

Professor Mohan Munasinghe Award

This award is for you and your team.

If you have successfully planned and implemented an energy management project within the past two years, apply for this award. The project may be associated with your work/employment or independently initiated by you or your team. Prof. Mohan Munasinghe, President Emeritus of SLEMA is sponsoring this award.

A wide range of projects qualify for this award. Here are some examples:

- A comprehensive energy audit and the partial or complete implementation of audit findings, in a factory or a commercial building.
- Improvements to a manufacturing process, methods or equipment, with the objective of achieving energy savings.
- Design and implementation of a novel, cost-effective energy system (eg. An energy efficient lighting system).
- Repairs, modifications and improvements to energy converting equipment to improve efficiency (eg. Analysis and replacement of insulation material in a kiln).

Ceylon Petroleum Corporation Award

This award is for your Institution.

You as a Manager or an Engineer in the Company, would have initiated, studied and implemented many energy management projects in your company, factory or the office.

Ceylon Petroleum Corporation is sponsoring this SLEMA award for the best energy management project implemented in an energy facility, factory or a building over the past two years.

Typical projects that qualify for this award are,

- Documented Company Energy Management Policy, Objectives, Strategies and their implementation, worker education and incentive programs to achieve high energy efficiency.
- Systematic implementation of result-oriented energy management efforts.
- Projects on energy substitution and renewable energy utilization.
- Optimization of environmental impacts of energy conversion devices and systems.
- Innovative projects implemented by energy utilities, independent power producers.
